## **What is DACA?**

DACA benefits youth who did not arrive to the United States by choice. These undocumented immigrant youth were brought to the U.S. by their parents when they were very young and as a result, their fates have been decided for them. The goal of the DACA process is to give these children a chance to live the U.S. without the fear of deportation.

While the DACA does not grant legal status to applicants, DACA gives the recipients authorization to work in the U.S., and the ability to apply for social security number and a driver's license.
