Santa Cruz area women will wear red in solidarity for 219 girls still missing after being kidnapped from their school in the Chibok Territory in Northern Nigeria on April 14.

Over 300 school girls were kidnapped from their dormitory by the terrorist group Boko Haram. These girls were studying for their exams and in the middle of the night armed men ripped them from their beds. As of June 20, 219 girls are still missing and the Nigerian government recently "closed" the investigation into securing their releases. Women across the world continue to experience inequities and violence. All concerned citizens need to renew pressure on the Nigerian government to re-commit to #BringBackOurGirls!
