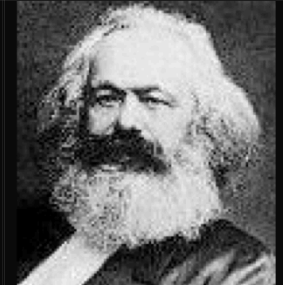

THE BEILIS AFFAIR OF 1913: A NEW DREYFUS AFFAIR IN CZARIST RUSSIA.

Lenin called The Beilis Affair of 1913 a new Dreyfus Affair in Russia. This was the last gasp of Czarism to divert revolutionary struggle into an anti-Jewish Pogrom. When Beilis was found not guilty the Russian working class launched a general strike condemning antisemitism. Bernard Malamud's book *The Fixer* about Menahem Mendel Beilis was made into a movie.
